Junior-Senior Prom, April 29th

Students are reminded that all Fayetteville Public School Student Code of Conduct policies, practices, and procedures are in place during the prom. A GUEST PERMISSION FORM must be completed for any students from other schools invited to the Prom and returned to Dr. Denise Hoy by the end of the day on April 26th. The forms are available in the ALLPS main office. Anyone over 20 years of age or students in junior high are not eligible to attend.

Prom tickets will go on sale April 11th. Juniors or seniors who owe a fine or fee will not be eligible to purchase a prom ticket until the fees are paid. Ticket sales will conclude on April 28st. The price of tickets are \$25 per person. Please be reminded tickets WILL NOT be sold at the door. The prom starts at 9:00pm and ends at midnight. Prom pictures will begin at 9:00 p.m. The picture packets range from \$15—\$50 and payment is due at the time pictures are taken.

Project Graduation

Project Graduation is a nationwide program which supports an all-night post-graduation event to provide seniors with a safe celebration on one of the most memorable nights of their lives. FHS Project Graduation will be held at the Fayetteville Boys and Girls Club from 10:00pm May 18, 2017 until 4:00am May 19, 2017. Tickets will be sold March 13-17 at the Early Bird price of \$15. Final ticket sales will be May 1-5 and tickets will be \$20. **Tickets can be purchased before school, during lunch and after school in ALLPS main office.** **NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE DOOR.**

GRADUATION PARTICIPATION — All class/coursework must be complete and turned in by Wednesday, May 17th @ MIDNIGHT. The **24 required graduation credits** must be complete in order to participate in graduation rehearsal and graduation ceremony on May 18th, 2017.

Day Of Graduation, May 18th

Students participating in the graduation exercise will be required to attend rehearsal at 11:00am on May 18th. Failure to attend the rehearsal may result in the student not being eligible to participate in the ceremony. If there is a conflict with the rehearsal, please see an assistant principal prior to the date of rehearsal. Parking is ONLY available at FHS, students parking at the University of Arkansas will be ticketed. Appropriate dress for graduation includes the following:



MALE

Dark dress shoes

Dark socks

White shirt and dark tie

Dark slacks (no jeans)

FEMALE

Dark dress or dark slacks

Dark dress shoes



Tassels are to be worn on the right side until you are told to change them at the end of the ceremony. Adding decorations or writing on caps or gowns is unacceptable. Students' attire will be checked prior to the start of commencement. A student dressed inappropriately may be prohibited from participating in the ceremony.

Following the ceremony FHS would appreciate donations of caps and gowns for students in the future who may not be able to pay for these items.

Students participating in the commencement program will need to be in line at Bud Walton Arena no later than 6:15 p.m.
