Fayetteville Schools will sponsor a summer school program for students who need to recover previously failed courses and get back on track to graduate. Students and families can use the information to consider the best opportunities for credit recovery in their summer planning.

WHERE: ALLPS Learning Center Room: A1, Computer lab
WHO: 9-12th grade students;
 Out of district student are able to enroll, but must check with their home school about credit acceptance.
WHEN: 8 different sessions available; students only need to sign up for one session at a time.

Note: Staffing for summer school is based on enrollments, thus we **DO NOT** provide REFUNDS. Students failing to course in the scheduled time frame will need to **PAY** to attend another session to gain credit(s). Any session is subject to cancellation when enrollment is not sufficient.

Cost: **\$150 per session**; no limit on credits recovered per session
\$25 per class (not to exceed \$150 per session) if qualifying for Catchup program (see criteria below)
 a. final grade in course must be 55-59% range, and
 b. student is recovering an NC due to excessive absences
***Limited Scholarships** are available for super seniors who qualify for free/reduced lunch

How: Register online at link below. Courses will be verified by summer school staff to ensure student is recovering the proper course.

Pay: Cash, check, and credit cards will be accepted. Pay upon arrival to student’s scheduled summer school session.

Food and Transportation: Responsibility of the student. Students are allowed to leave campus for lunch.
